The Philomath Community Foundation (PCF) will award a scholarship to a Philomath High School or Kings Valley Senior upon graduating from high school. The emphasis of the scholarship is to recognize students who plan to enroll after high school with the intention of pursuing a higher education degree. Emphasis will be placed on the graduate who exhibits dedication, integrity, drive, potential and need.

Eligibility requirements for receiving the scholarship:

1. Student must be from the Philomath School District or Kings Valley Charter School with a cumulative GPA of 3.75.
2. Pass required state testing.
3. Attach a copy of your high school transcript.

- Attach a copy of your high school transcript
- Please submit two letters of recommendation. One letter must be from a PHS teacher or guidance counselor, and one letter must be from a community member. Both letters should be a brief endorsement and written by individuals who are not related to you.

A completed application and a written recommendation of the student applicant from one teacher or high school counselor (neither related to the applicant) is required. The written recommendation should be a personal endorsement of the applicant's qualification meeting the requirements of this scholarship and must be submitted with the scholarship application.

The completed Application with letters of recommendation must be submitted to the PHS Guidance Center by April 15th at 4:00PM. (If the 15th falls on the weekend, the due date is the following Monday at 4:00PM.)

Incomplete applications will not be considered.
