The Philomath Community Foundation (PCF) will award this scholarship to a Philomath School District graduating senior. Emphasis for the award of this scholarship will be for those students who have attended Blodgett Elementary School for a minimum of two years, and who have supported the Philomath area communities in various community service activities. Applicants must plan to enroll in a continuing educational institution such as a vocational-technical school; a community college, or a 4-year university. There is no minimum gpa requirement.

Eligibility requirements:

- Student must have attended the Blodgett Elementary School for a minimum of two academic years
- Student must attach Philomath School District proof of attendance at Blodgett Elementary School
- Student must be graduating from Philomath High School or Philomath Academy
- Attach required letter(s) of recommendation. See below for instructions
- Attach a copy of the applicant's most recent high school transcripts
