The Philomath Community Foundation (PCF) will award this scholarship to a Philomath School District graduating senior. It will be awarded to a student who is active in music and/or the performing arts and who plans to enroll in a college or university to pursue a Bachelor's degree in Science, Technology, Engineering (including Robotics), Mathematics or Computer Science.

Priority will be given to women, minorities, and those with financial need.

Eligibility requirements:

- Student must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.4
- Student must be pursuing a degree in a STEM area
- Attach required letter(s) of recommendation. See below for instructions
- Attach a copy of the applicant's most recent high school transcripts

The written recommendations should be personal endorsements of the applicant's qualifications to meet the requirements of this scholarship.

The completed application, including all required attachments, must be submitted to the PHS Guidance Center by April 15th prior to 3:00 pm. (If the 15th falls on a weekend, the due date for the application packets will be the following Monday prior to 3:00 pm).
