The Philomath Community Foundation (PCF) will award a scholarship to a Philomath High School Senior upon graduating from high school. The scholarship will be given to a student who is active in music and/or performing arts and who will enroll in a college or university to pursue a Bachelor's degree in Science, Technology, Engineering, Math, or Computer Science. Priority will be given to women, minorities and those with financial need.

Eligibility requirements for receiving the scholarship:

1. Student must be from the Philomath School District with a cumulative GPA of 3.4.
2. Pass required state testing.
3. Attach a copy of your high school transcript.
4. Recipient must pursue a degree in a STEM area.

- Describe your plans for continuing post high school education

- Please include a letter of recommendation from a community member (Not related to you). The letter should be a brief, signed endorsement of you. Each written endorsement is to be included with the scholarship application. The writer should include their name and how they know the applicant.

A completed application and a written recommendation of the student applicant from one teacher and one community member (neither related to the applicant) is required. The written recommendation should be a personal endorsement of the applicant's qualification meeting the requirements of this scholarship and must be submitted with the scholarship application.

The completed Application with letters of recommendation must be submitted to the PHS Guidance Center by April 15th at 4:00PM. (If the 15th falls on the weekend, the due date is the following Monday at 4:00PM.)

Incomplete applications will not be considered.
